Remember:

Choose a pediatrician close to your home. Check to make sure your pediatrician takes insurance. Added conveniences at a pediatrician office include: weekend sick hours, a lab on site for blood draws and after-hours call availability. Many offices will meet parents ahead of time to discuss their practice; if desired, schedule this before you deliver.
