



NESTED LLC: COVID-19 Disclosure Statements*

Nestled LLC believes the health of our clients, instructors, and members of our administrative and operations team is of utmost importance. We are closely monitoring and will adhere to public health guidelines to maintain best practices to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

I. **Nestled Health & Safety Protocols**

When Nestled LLC resumes its Nestledbaby.com in-person classes in June 2020 or thereafter, some new protocols will be in place to help ensure the health and safety of our clients, instructors and team members. These will include:

- Nestled LLC team members and instructors will sanitize all surfaces between classes.
- Nestled LLC has always sterilized and will continue to sterilize all CPR & choking practice dolls, swaddling blankets and other materials used in class before & after each class as well as only uses single-use face shield/lung bags.
- Nestled LLC will pre-mark locations for all class participants to ensure there is a minimum of 6 feet of separation per government agencies' social distancing guidelines.
- Nestled instructors and/or team members will not teach nor attend any in-person Nestled classes if they have any symptoms of COVID-19, and will remain quarantined for a period of 14 days.
- Upon arrival, all class participants will be required to:
 1. Have a temperature check before entering the classroom.
 2. Be asked to confirm that they have not had a fever, cough or shortness of breath within the past 14 days, nor been exposed to someone who has.
 3. Sanitize their hands.
 4. Be required to wear a mask.

Should a class participant arrive on-site and refuse to adhere to these protocols, the participant will be denied entry. There will be no refunds for missed classes under these circumstances.

If you are a member of a high-risk group, Nestled LLC recommends that you elect to take Nestled's online virtual class option in lieu of its in-person group or private classes.
