According to reviews, people who use this program sleep more than six hours on a weekly basis, 55 percent say that they spend less time awake dining the night, and 43 percent say that It takes them less time to fall asleep.		You have four levels of pricing - Basic ones are The SHUTI Self Help (149 dollars) and The SHUTI Professional (174 dollars) that include the access to a clinician and lasts twenty-six weeks. If You want to use them for a year, prices are 215 dollars and 249 dollars.
